They learn to receive a pass by bending their knees and getting the majority of their stick on the ground.	2 v 1 situations. Pupils practice using passing to evade a static opponent. They learn when to time their pass so that it is not intercepted.	Small sided games. Pupils learn the rules and play fairly together.	Assessment through participation in small sided games.
<b>Y4 working towards milestone 2 objectives.</b>	Pupils learn to hold the hockey stick with their hands in the correct position. Pupils learn to dribble, keeping control of the ball. Pupils learn to maintain control whilst changing speed and direction using the open side of their stick.	Pupils learn to use the reverse stick drag to dodge and evade an opponent.	Pupils learn to pass the ball accurately to a partner using a push pass to the open stick side. They receive passes with soft hands so that the ball does not bounce away from their stick.	2 v 1 situations. Pupils learn to work together to eliminate a defender. The defender has to stay in a set zone and cannot tackle. The player with the ball must decide when to pass, or if it is better to dribble.	Small sided games. Pupils learn the rules and play fairly together. They take it in turns to captain their team.	Assessment through participation in small sided games.
